

Potential Virtual Activities

- GeoGuessr: <https://www.geoguessr.com>
 - Description: Explore the outdoors through Google streetview. The game drops players at a random location in the streetview and players “drive” around to identify where they are.
 - Suggestion on how to play virtually:
 - Creating a free account on GeoGuessr lets you play one free game a day
 - Designate one person as the “driver” and have them share their screen with everyone else. Everyone works together to find clues about where you are and make a guess on the world map.

- Pictionary
 - Description: Players try to guess a word from drawings by one player.
 - Suggestion on how to play virtually:
 - Use an online word generator such as <https://www.thegamegal.com/word-generator/>
 - The player drawing can either use a digital sketch program and share screen. Or draw on paper and hold up to the camera.
 - The group can form teams and compete or play all together collaboratively.
 - This could also potentially be done using the ‘whiteboard’ function in Zoom. One player shares their screen and selects the whiteboard. The same player who is screen-sharing uses the annotation tools on the toolbar to draw a picture with the mouse. Everyone else takes turns guessing what the picture is! If it’s your turn, you’ll have to share the screen, then take turns screen-sharing according to who’s turn it is.

- Codenames
 - Description: Two teams compete to guess their agents from clues given by the spymaster.
 - Suggestion on how to play virtually:
 - The official digital version has not been released yet, but there are many fan-made versions such as <https://www.horsepaste.com>
 - Designate one spymaster to control the board and make the selection on behalf of everyone. This spymaster should send the other spymaster the image of the key through an email or text message that is not visible to the other players.

- Virtually visit a museum or famous site
 - Some possibilities:
